


Political devision & representation

- Alitaal RM is divided into 8 wards
- RM center (HQ) is located in ward no. 5
- Ward no.3 is largest ward by geographical coverage
- Ward no.5 is smallest ward by geographical coverage
- 24190 hectors Land is coverage by forest.
- 66 % of total household are access in electricity.
- 5 female members are elected as rural municipal executive members.
- 3 dalit members are representing in RME
- 4 Janjati members are representing in RME

Major efforts of RM

- Preparation of dynamic Digital Municipal profile and 5 year periodic plan.
- Establishment of Digital library and ICT lab in high school.
- Establish of Digital notice board.
- More than 40 bylaws, guidelines and manuals have been prepared and implementing.
- Preparation the master plan, video documentary of major tourism destination "Aalital" and construction of different infrastructures.(ongoing)
- Aalital transportation master plan in process of preparation.
- DPR of Aalital Gankhet road has been prepared and ongoing to implement.

Major efforts of RM Continued.....

- Different structures on Conservation of bio-diversity and reservoir.
- Finalize the center of wards.
- Use of Vital Event Registration and Social Protection-Management Information System.
- Construction of Assembly hall and other many small infrastructures.
- Construction Hi-tech nursery.
- Use of mobile apps and other social media for delivery of information.
- Promotion of Vocational agriculture, live stock based and other small industry. "One village one production"

Water Supply Sanitation & Hygiene (WASH)

- RM has been already declared ODF
- All schools have toilet facilities but need to manage and somewhere is needed to improvements.
- 1532 (55.87%) households are getting water from safe piped water supply system.
- 1210 (44.13%) households are using drinking water directly from spring sources, traditional Naulos or very old piped system schemes.

RVWRMP support in Alitaal- Phase III

- Support to prepare RM level Water Use Master Plan (WUMP) & Livelihoods Implementation Plan (LIP).
- 12 DWSS schemes are completed with benefiting 681 HHs/3880 population.
- 5 schemes are under construction and scheduled to be completed by end of this fiscal year. These 5 schemes will benefit 551 households/3732 population.
- 4 schemes (3 Water supplies & 1 multi-use scheme) are proposed as a new schemes. The schemes agreement will be done for implementation phase by end of December 2019.
- 7 users committees out of 12 schemes are affiliated with cooperative to get operation and maintenance support from cooperative if they needed in the future.

RVWRMP support in Alitaal- Phase III, Continued.....

- 1 MUS (DWS + Irrigation) scheme has been implemented. The scheme benefiting 164 households and 830 populations.
- 64 Home Garden groups are formed and trained on basic home garden training. A total 1860 members (of which 80% are women) are affiliated in home garden groups.
- 212 persons trained on Income generating activities
- 1 Cooperative (Chetana small farmer Agriculture Cooperative Ltd.) is developed and supported by RVWRMP.

Major support of UNDP in Aalital RM

- Support in Milk Transportation Vehicle.
- Constructing a view tower and other structures at Aalital.
- Promoting Homestay in Janjati Magar Community.
- Promoting Bee-Keeping, Local Chicken, Pig farming, Patato and Banana farming.
- Conducting different activities to promote good governance.

Major Opportunities in Alitaal RM

- Employment opportunity and economic promotion by proper utilization of different local resources.
- Tourism promotion
- Vegetable/Fruit production
- Honey production and processing
- Availability of local markets & provincial markets are also nearer (Comparing to other RMs/municipalities)
- Transportation facilities
- RMs are free with constitutional rights to prepare and implement different policies, guidelines for their own needs and local development.

Major Issues

- Geographical distress.
- Inconvenience of traffic and road.
- Depletion of Water sources.
- Poor utilization of natural local resources.
- Different legal complications.
- Lack of training and exposures.
- Lack of public awareness.

- Lack of sectorial skilled man power

- Poor access of electricity and communication facility
- Lack of employment opportunities
- Natural disaster

Future Plan of RM


- Free and better education and health to all people of Aalital.
